

Competition Information document – Health & Life Sciences

Pre-Brief

The Health and Social Care competition is designed to allow learners to demonstrate their understanding of Health & Safety in the environment. Learners will display their comprehension of the importance of the risks and hazards that arise in Health and Social Care settings.

Competitors will be asked to:

- Complete risk assessment, as part of this they will need to be able to identify hazards and potential risk posed. Then recognize and record the preventative action required.

Competitors will be given 1 hour and 30 minutes to complete.

Entry Requirements

The competition is for the learners working towards Level 1.

Competitors must be 16 years of age or over.

A maximum of 3 competitors per organisation may enter.

A statement of support that outlines any individual needs of the learner within the competition - i.e.: support with communication etc. will need to be completed by on the day prior to beginning the competition.

The competition will be open for entries from 1 March 2018 to 7 April 2018 through the WordSkills UK entry system. For the most up to date information please check the Natspec website.
