







Competition Information document - Media

Pre Brief

Each team will be provided with a workstation, internet access, drawing and mark making materials and storyboard templates.

Participants must be in teams of 3.

- Participants are able to carry out initial research on the 'Horror' film genre in advance of the competition. They are encouraged to bring the research materials with them for the competition.
- You will work in teams of 3 to produce a storyboard for a short Horror film sequence based on images provided for you at the competition. You will need to select appropriate annotation (which should include camera movement, edit transitions, effects and sound for this on the day).
- Final story boards must be formally presented at the end of the competition. Presentations should last 2-4 minutes and each team member must participate.

You will be given 90 minutes to produce your storyboard and 30 minutes to plan and practice your presentation.

Entry Requirements

The competition is for the learners working towards Level 1.

Competitors must be 16 years of age or over.

A maximum of 3 competitors per organisation may enter.

A statement of support that outlines any individual needs of the learner within the competition - i.e.: support with communication etc. will need to be completed by on the day prior to beginning the competition.
